## WHAT YOU MUST KNOW PRIOR TO YOUR DEPARTURE TO ISRAEL

## All Vaccinated and Non-Vaccinated travelers are welcome!

- Testing is no longer required for anyone traveling to Israel.
- The requirements of proof of a negative PCR/Antigen test prior to departure, as well as the PCR test and isolation upon arrival – have been cancelled.
- Travelers will still be required to fill in an entry statement in the 48 hours prior to departure to Israel.

Fill out the health declaration within 48 hours from departing to Tel Aviv, by filling out the appropriate information related to the Traveler: <a href="https://corona.health.gov.il/en/flights">https://corona.health.gov.il/en/flights</a>.

- The mask mandate for international flights to/from Israel will be lifted.
- Within one day of your flight's departure from Israel to the USA, an Rapid Antigen test (\$30) or PCR test (\$50) is required.
