DAY 1 - MON, MAY 13, 2024 - DEPARTURE FROM USA.

DAY 2 - TUE, MAY 14, 2024: EUROPE / TEL AVIV

Arrival Tel Aviv. Our life-changing journey begins as we arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport. We will be met by our representative. After boarding our bus, we will transfer to the hotel for overnight in Netanya or Tel Aviv.

DAY 3 - WED, MAY 15, 2024:

CAESAREA / MT. CARMEL / MEGIDDO /NAZARETH

After breakfast, we travel by private motor coach along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea, where Gentiles first heard the Good News from Peter and were baptized. We'll see the Roman Amphitheatre and aqueduct, and then journey on to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah challenged King Ahab and the prophets of Baal. Next, we travel through the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo Armageddon Battlefield, where archaeologists have unearthed 20 levels of civilization. We make our way to Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle at the wedding feast and then to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. Check in, dinner and overnight in Galilee. overnight in Galilee.

DAY 4- THU, MAY 16, 2024:

CAESAREA PHILIPPI / CAPERNAUM / BAPTISM
Following breakfast, our morning travels take us to two valuable northern sites. Dan is where the children of Israel fell to the depths of alternative sacrifice and Caesarea Philippi, the site of Peter's Confession and pagan worship. Our visit continues to the Mt. of Beatitudes to gain a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy lunch of St. Peter's Fish Lunch on own (other selections available), we then visit the ancient Fisherman Boat followed by a relaxing cruise on the Sea of Galilee. In Capernaum we view the excavations of the seaside village and Peter's home. Finally, we have an opportunity to be baptized at the Jordan River Baptismal site before we return to our hotel. dinner and overnight in Galilee.

DAY 5 - FRI, MAY 17, 2024: BORDER CROSSING / NEBO / AMMAN CITADEL / PETRA OVERNIGHT

We will cross the border to Jordan Enjoy our stop at Mt. Nebo, believed to be the site of the tomb of Moses, which commands spectacular views across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. Then we drive to Amman Citadel is an archeological site at the center of downtown Amman. Lastly, we drive to Petra for check in, dinner and overnight.



DAY 6 - SAT, MAY 18, 2024 DEAD SEA - PETRA FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING —

DEAD SEA - PETRA FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING — WADI RUM This morning we drive to Petra here we enjoy a walking tour through the "Siq," an immense crack in the Nubian sandstone, to the city of Petra carved out of the rose red rock. The Treasury, El Khazneh, is one of the most elegant remains of antiquity. Beyond El Khazneh we are surrounded on both sides by hundreds of Petra's carved and built structures. After the guided part of the tour you will have the afternoon to explore—perhaps you will want to hike up the 822 steps carved out of the mountain to the Monastery building – its large, intricately carved façade and views looking out over the surrounding valleys are stunning. Other things to see include the pillars of the Hadrian Gate and the Cardo beyond it – a long street that was once the ancient city's main thoroughfare. We take some time to explore at your own leisure. We drive to Wadi Rum which is the biggest desert in Jordan and protected area where Sir Laurence wrote the seven pillars of wisdom. Dinner and overnight at Wadi Rum.

DAY 7 - SUN, MAY 19, 2024:

DAY 7 - SUN, MAY 19, 2024:
WADI RUM JEEP TOUR / ARAVA / TIMNA / EILAT
Breakfast and check out. Enjoy a 2 hours Jeep tour in the
desert. We arrive at Arava Crossing the southernmost
border crossing connecting Israel and Jordan. We stop
at Timna Park. Located in the center of the Edom Valley,
in the Arava, approximately 25 km north of Eilat, Timna
Park is considered one of the largest parks in Israel.
Timna provides the perfect desert backdrop to display
this fascinating replica of the Tabernacle, built in a
complete, accurate and authentic reconstruction of the
appearance, dimensions, and colors of the 'Mishkan',
used by the people of Israel, in the wilderness. Inside
visitors can view exact models of the altar, the copper
sink, the table of showbread, the menorah, the ark of the
covenant, vestments of the priests, and more.
Lastly, we arrive in Eilat check in, dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 - MON, MAY 20, 2024: EILAT / BEERSHEVA / MASADA / DEAD SEA

OVERNIGHT ISRAEL Breakfast and check out. We drive to Tel Be'er Sheva, the area in which the forefathers of the Jewish nation (Abraham, Isaac and Jacob) lived and worked, is an important biblical tel – one of three from the days of the Bible that UNESCO has included in its list of world heritage sites. Thereafter we enjoy a cable car ride to the mount top fortress of Masada. We drive to the Dead Sea Israel for check in, dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 TUE, MAY 21, 2024:
QUMRAN / HEBRON / BETHLEHEM
Breakfast and check out. We visit Qumran Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. We continue our tour to Bethlehem. Here our guide will treat us to the history of the famous zealot stand. We will visit the Church of the Nativity, the birthplace of Jesus, and Shepherds Fields (Luke 2:1-20) then the Field of Boaz and Ruth (Ruth 1:16-17 & 4:13). Our last stop is Hebron. Drive to Jerusalem, check in, dinner and overnight.

DAY 10 WED, MAY 22, 2024:

DAY 10 WED, MAY 22, 2024:
MT OLIVES - CITY OF DAVID

After a night of rest and a hearty breakfast, this exciting day will begin with a drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (Matt. 24:3) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Chapel of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster and the Dominus Flevit. We will walk along Hosanna Road to the Gethsemane to visit the Church of All Nations that stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (Matt. 26:36-57). See the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. We stop at the Biblical City of David, and journey through the underground tunnels through which the city was conquered and residents fled (Hezekiah's Tunnel). Return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. dinner and overnight.

DAY 11-THU, MAY 23, 2024:

DAY 11 -THU, MAY 23, 2024:

OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM AND BETHANY

Then we enjoy a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Starting at the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) where the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God, we continue to the Temple Area of Mt. Moriah. Visit the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (Genesis 22:9-14) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (Genesis 22) and where the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. After this we walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, and the Ecce Homo Arch (John 19:13) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (Mark 15:6). Then we continue through the Old City bazaars to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Free time in the Old City. In the afternoon we visit Bethany. Drive to Jerusalem, dinner and overnight.

DAY 12 FRI, MAY 24, 2024: New Jerusalem / MT Zion / Farwell Dinner /

Breakfast and check out. We drive to the Israeli Museum to see the Dead Sea Scrolls, and enjoy a walk through an accurately detailed model of Biblical Jerusalem. This model will help put into perspective all that you have seen over the previous days touring We enjoy a tour of New Jerusalem, see Yad Vashem – the immensely moving memorial to the six million martyrs of the Holocaust. Thereafter we drive to Mt. Zion where we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu on the site of Caiphas' House, the Room of the Last Supper (Luke 22:14-20) and the Tomb of King David. We end our visits at the Garden Tomb and Golgotha – Place of the Skull – for a worship service. We then enjoy a Farwell dinner before our return flight.

DAY 13 SAT. MAY 25. 2024:

We arrive in the US and make our way home. The end of a most exciting, inspirational, and enjoyable journey.
