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

THE MINISTRY TRAINING INSTITUTE WITH DR. MICHAEL C. WALKER











DAY 1: MON JAN 4 - USA - TEL AVIV. Tour members gather at the ticket counter at the airport two hours prior to the departure to Israel. Dinner and breakfast are served in flight.

DAY 2: TUE JAN 5 - TEL AVIV. Upon our arrival at the Tel Aviv airport, we are met and drive northward along the Way of the Sea to Caesarea, the Roman City of Herod and the port from which the Apostle Paul sailed to Rome. We visit the Crusader's Castle, the Roman Amphitheater and aqueduct. Enjoy a walk on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. Drive through the citrus groves and farms of the rich land of Sharon to our hotel - situated on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea (pending flight arrival). Dinner is served at our hotel. Weather permitting, we suggest a walk on the beach.

DAY 3: WED JAN 6 - MT. CARMEL - GALILEE. After a good night's rest and a hearty breakfast, we begin the thrilling journey of following in the footsteps of Jesus. This morning we visit Haifa and Mt. Carmel - the biblical site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Driving through the Jezreel Valley we visit Megiddo and continue to the fields of Armageddon (Revelation 16:16). Traveling eastward across Galilee, we view Mt. Tabor (Psalm 89:12) and Deboriya - the hometown of the prophetess Deborah - at the foothill of Mt. Tabor (Judges 4 and 5). Dinner and overnight at our hotel on the shores of the beautiful Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4: THU JAN 7 - TIBERIAS - CAPERNAUM - CAESAREA PHILIPPI - MT. HERMON - GOLAN HEIGHTS. This day will be an exciting day in the Galilee area after a delicious breakfast. We depart from the Roman hot springs resort city of Tiberias via boat across the Sea of Galilee to

Capernaum (John 6:24) to walk among the ancient ruins of the first century synagogue where Jesus preached (Matthew 4:1317). Then on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where lesus preached the "Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 57) and to Tabgha - the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes - (Mark 6:3444). We then proceed to upper Galilee and the site of Peter's confession (Matthew 16:16) at Caesarea Philippi and to Mt. Hermon (Psalm 89:12) the probable site of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:18) and the present day Golan Heights where Israel, Lebanon and Syria come together. We follow the fresh mountain waters of Mt. Hermon to the Sea of Galilee and to the outlet passage at the southern tip of the Sea. We stop at the beautiful Pilgrims Park at the Jordan River for an optional Baptism. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



DAY 5: FRI JAN 8 - TIBERIAS - MT. NEBO - PETRA Today we depart Tiberias and drive to the Sheik Hussein Bridge and cross into Jordan. Continue to Mt. Nebo and Madaba and then on to Petra "The Rose Red City - Half as Old as Time". Dinner and overnight at our hotal

DAY 6: SAT JAN 9 - PETRA - DEAD SEA (JORDAN). This morning after breakfast, we visit Petra. This ancient Edomite and Nabatean capital is an amazing city of prophecy. See this spectacular "City of the Dead" with its famed gorge, ancient street, temples, dwelling places and tombs carved from the solid rock. We arrive at El Ji Post and continue on the one-mile journey on horseback or walk, passing through the famous SIQ (natural gorge) and arrive at the "Treasury". Visit the ancient theater, the Nabatean Judgment Hall, Place Tombs, famous Urn Temple and the Roman amphitheater. Those willing to climb may view the monastery, Jebel Harun (Mountain of Aaron) - reputed to be the burial place of Aaron. Carriage or horseback journey back to El Ji Post. Continue north to the Dead Sea on the Jordan side - the lowest point on earth – and time for a swim before dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: SUN JAN 10 - DEAD SEA - JERUSALEM. This morning we drive to the Allenby Bridge to return back to Israel. We again rejoin our bus and guide from the Holy Land. Drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (Matthew 24:3) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Chapel of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster and the Dominus Flevit. Walk along Hosanna Road to the Gethsemane Garden to visit the Church of All Nations that stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (Matthew 26:3657). See the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. We then drive to Mt. Zion where we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu on the site of Caiaphas' House, the Room of the Last Supper (Luke 22:1420) and the Tomb of King David. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in the Holy City.

DAY 8: MON JAN 11 - MASADA - DEAD SEA - QUMRAN - JERICHO - BETHANY. This morning, we drive via the Judean Desert towards the Dead Sea - the lowest point on earth. A beautiful new road takes us south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, a truly remarkable piece of history. We ascend Masada by cable car to walk among the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70-73 A.D., the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean Revolt against Rome and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth century Byzantine church are still on view. Return along the Dead Sea to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit the remains of the Community Center of

the Essenes and the Caves of the Scrolls. Drive through Jericho to Old Jericho for a visit. We continue on the Jericho Road viewing the Inn of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:2537). Then we visit Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus (John 11:146). Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: TUE JAN 12 - JERUSALEM - BETHLEHEM. Today begins with a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Starting at the Western (Wailing) Wall where the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God, we continue to the Temple area of Mt. Moriah (the Temple Mount). View the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (Genesis 22:914) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (Genesis 22) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. After this, we walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, the Ecce Homo Arch (John 19:13) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (Mark 15:6). This afternoon, we continue our tour to Bethlehem. We visit the Church of the Nativity, the birthplace of Jesus, and Shepherds Fields (Luke 2:120) then the Field of Boaz and Ruth (Ruth 1:1617 & 4:13). We return to Jerusalem passing Rachel's Tomb (if viewable). Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

DAY 10: WED JAN 13 - JERUSALEM. Today is a day at leisure for activities of your own. Return to the hotel tonight for dinner and overnight.

DAY 11: THU JAN 14 - JERUSALEM - AIRPORT. This morning we drive to the Old City to walk around the bazaars and towards the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Visit the Garden Tomb and Golgotha - Place of the Skull - for a worship service. Continue to tour New Jerusalem: Hebrew University, the Shrine of the Book that houses the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Model City of Jerusalem which depicts in miniature the Holy City as it appeared in the first century. Visit Yad Vashem - the immensely moving memorial to the six million martyrs of the Holocaust. Then, on to a local restaurant for our Farewell Dinner. Continue to the airport for our late evening flight to the U.S.

DAY 12: FRI JAN 15 - ARRIVE USA. Arrive early in the morning and continue home - the end of a most enjoyable journey.



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
